TuBAR® High Security Locks are spring loaded and require proper key orientation before operation:

- ➔ Orient key properly, insert completely, then rotate to open
- ➔ TuBAR® is not designed as a compression latch:
 - Unlock TuBAR® before releasing any pressurized door seal security screws
 - Tighten any door seal security screws before re-locking TuBAR®

Confirm correct lock installation and operation with regular inspections of the application and all keys:

- ➔ Verify smooth lock operation and inspect for tampering, foreign objects or damaged keys
- ➔ Damage caused by excessive force to lock or key may void warranty
- ➔ Installation adjustments or modifications should be completed by qualified installation or maintenance personnel

DO NOT use oil based lubricants (WD-40) which can attract dirt. Introduction of any acid-based chemical will void warranty. Use a contact cleaner, then lubricate with a Teflon or graphite-based spray.
